1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CENTRAL COORDINATION OF
3 SUPPLEMENTAL POSTTAX INSURANCE PRODUCTS AVAILABLE TO
4 STATE EMPLOYEES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes is amended by
7 adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 126-4.2. Central coordination of supplemental posttax insurance products.**

9 (a) The State Personnel Commission shall coordinate the establishment of a
10 Centralized Supplemental Benefits Committee to offer posttax supplemental benefit
11 options on a statewide basis to State agencies, departments, institutions, and The
12 University of North Carolina. The Committee shall review plan options, prepare request
13 for proposals, and select plan providers upon a thorough and competitive procurement
14 process. Terms of contracts shall follow purchase and contract guidelines in Article 23
15 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes. State agencies, departments, institutions, and
16 The University of North Carolina may choose to participate in the Centralized
17 Supplemental Benefits Committee or elect to offer certain benefits options as provided
18 in G.S. 58-31-60.

19 (b) The Centralized Supplemental Benefits Committee shall be composed of a
20 minimum of seven representatives from participating State agencies, departments,
21 institutions, and The University of North Carolina. The Committee prior to nominations
22 shall develop qualifications for the Committee members. The participating State
23 agencies, departments, institutions, and The University of North Carolina shall submit
24 nominations to the Director of the Office of State Personnel for consideration.
25 Committee members shall serve three-year terms on a rotating basis as established by
26 the initial appointment. The Office of State Personnel shall provide administrative
27 support to the Committee."

28 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
