The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 90-210.25 is amended by adding the follow	ing new
subsection to read:	
"(e1) The taking or recovery of human tissue at a funeral establishmen	t by any
person is prohibited, except that this prohibition does not apply to:	
(1) A licensee under this Article that performs embalming or of	otherwise 1
prepares a dead human body in the ordinary course of business	s, and
(2) The Chief Medical Examiner or anyone acting under the	ne Chief
Medical Examiner's authority.	
No funeral establishment or person licensed under this Article shall permit the	<u>he taking</u>
or recovery of human tissue from a dead human body in its custody or co	ntrol for
human transplantation purposes or for research purposes. No funeral establish	<u>hment or</u>
any of its licensees, agents, or employees shall accept, solicit, or offer to ac	
payment, gratuity, commission, or compensation of any kind for referring	<u>potential</u>
tissue donors to a tissue bank or tissue broker or to an eye bank or eye broker	ker. For
purposes of this subsection, the term "tissue" does not include an eye."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies	to deaths

occurring on and after that date.
