2	AN ACT TO PROTECT CONSUMERS FROM UNLAWFUL SALE OF ADMISSION			
3	TICKETS IN EXCESS OF THE PRINTED PRICE.			
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	SECTION 1. Article 44 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding			
6	a new section to read:			
7	7 " <u>§ 14-344.1. Internet sale of admission tickets in excess of printed price.</u>			
8	(a) Notwithstanding G.S. 14-344, nothing shall prohibit the resale or offering for			
9	resale via the Internet of an admission ticket, at any price, to an athletic contest, dance,			
10	theater, concert, circus, or other amusement, if the organizer of the event or the operator			
11	of the location where the event is occurring authorize admission tickets to the event to			
12	be resold for more than the price printed on the face of the ticket. If such resale is			
13	authorized, any admission ticket to the event may be resold or offered for resale through			
14	any Web site if the Web site's operator guarantees a full refund of the amount paid for			
15	the ticket under each of the following conditions:			
16	(1) The ticketed event is cancelled.			
17	(2) The purchaser is denied admission to the ticketed event, unless the			
18	denial is due to the action or omission of the purchaser.			
19	(3) The ticket is not delivered to the purchaser in the manner described on			
20	the Web site or pursuant to the delivery guarantee made by the reseller			
21	and the failure results in the purchaser's inability to attend the ticketed			
22	event.			
23	(b) A Web site operator's guarantee pursuant to this section shall be posted on the			
24	operator's Web site and a prospective purchaser shall be directed to such guaranty			
25	before completion of the resale transaction.

1	(c) A refund issued by a Web site operator pursuant to any of the conditions
2	provided for in this section shall include any service, handling, or processing fees unless
3	the fees are declared nonrefundable under the terms of the guarantee.
4	(d) If authorization to resell an admission ticket for more than the price printed
5	on the face of the ticket is not granted by the organizer of the event or the operator of
6	the location of the event pursuant to this section, no person or entity shall resell an
7	admission ticket for more than the price printed on the face of the ticket.
8	(e) The provisions of this section shall not apply to student tickets issued by
9	institutions of higher education in North Carolina for sporting events."
10	SECTION 2. Article 44 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
11	adding a new section to read:
12	" <u>§ 14-344.1. Bar on purchasing tickets in excess of maximum ticket limit.</u>
13	(a) For purposes of this section, the term "original ticket seller" means the issuer
14	of a ticket or a person or firm who provides distribution services or ticket sales services
15	under a contract with the issuer.
16	(b) Whoever knowingly purchases from the original ticket seller a quantity of
17	tickets to an event that exceeds the maximum ticket limit quantity posted by or on
18	behalf of the original ticket seller at the point of original sale or printed on the tickets
19	themselves and intends to resell such tickets shall be in violation of G.S. 75-1.1.
20	(c) <u>A person or firm is not liable under this section with respect to tickets for</u>
21	which that person or firm is the original ticket seller."
22	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
23	offenses committed on or after that date.
