SECTION 1.(a) All noncertified public school employees who were paid		
less than the fair minimum wage, as defined in Section 7.4(d) of S. L. 2006-66, for the		
2005-2006 school year shall receive:		
(1	A salary adjustment retroactive to July 1, 2005, to increase the	eir salary
	to the fair minimum wage, and	
(2	2) A salary adjustment retroactive to July 1, 2006, to increa	ase their
	adjusted 2005-2006 salary by the legislative salary incremen	t of five
	and one-half percent (5½%).	
<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> Nothing in this act shall affect in any way salary increases		
for noncertified public school employees for the 2007-2008 school year.		

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
