2	AN ACT TO CORRECT THE INEQUITY THAT EXISTS IN PAY FOR
3	NONCERTIFIED SCHOOL EMPLOYEES DUE TO THE ONE-YEAR DELAY IN
4	IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE-MANDATED FAIR MINIMUM WAGE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1.(a) All noncertified public school employees who were paid
7	less than the fair minimum wage, as defined in Section 7.4(d) of S. L. 2006-66, for the
8	2005-2006 school year shall receive:
9	(1) A salary adjustment retroactive to July 1, 2005, to increase their salary
10	to the fair minimum wage, and
11	(2) A salary adjustment retroactive to July 1, 2006, to increase their
12	adjusted 2005-2006 salary by the legislative salary increment of five
13	and one-half percent $(5\frac{1}{2}\%)$.
14	SECTION 1.(b) Nothing in this act shall affect in any way salary increases
15	for noncertified public school employees for the 2007-2008 school year.
16	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
