9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10	SECTION 1.(a) The Department of Crime Control and Public Safety shall
11	study the procedures of local law enforcement and health care facilities when persons
12	with dementia or other cognitive impairments are reported missing. The Department of
13	Crime Control and Public Safety shall consult with the Department of Health and
14	Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, in conducting the study. The
15	study shall examine the following:
16	(1) The coordination of search efforts among local and statewide agencies.
17	(2) The search methods utilized when persons with dementia or other
18	cognitive impairments are reported missing.
19	SECTION 1.(b) In response to the study authorized in this section, the
20	Department of Crime Control and Public Safety shall present findings and
21	recommendations, including any proposed statutory changes, to the North Carolina
22	Study Commission on Aging on or before March 1, 2008.
23	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
