2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE BASIC EDUCATION RESOURCE
4	TREATMENT INITIATIVE (BERT).
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7	Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of one
8	million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. These funds shall be
9	allocated for the Basic Education Resource Treatment (BERT) Initiative to:
10	(1) Address the academic and social ills of the HIV/AIDS/STDs at-risk
11	population;
12	(2) Heighten awareness of HIV/AIDS/STDs of the populations at risk for
13	these diseases;
14	(3) Develop and use resources in the community to assist people and their
15	families who are affected by AIDS;
16	(4) Educate, enlighten, and inform women, children, and their families on
17	the reality of AIDS, debunking the myths that persist about the
18	disease; and
19	(5) Provide services with emphasis on prevention and education on
20	HIV/AIDS/STDs in North Carolina.
21	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
