Short Title: Study Mandatory Boating Safety Education. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Wray; Underhill and Wainwright.

Referred to: Wildlife Resources, if favorable, Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION TO STUDY
MANDATORY BOATING SAFETY EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall study the feasibility of implementing mandatory boating education in this State. In conducting its study, the Commission shall evaluate the feasibility of requiring all persons to satisfy boating education requirements prior to operating a motorboat or personal watercraft.

SECTION 2. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the 2008 Session of the 2007 General Assembly.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
