A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND
3 ITS CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL NOT COUNT OUT-OF-STATE
4 STUDENTS AS IN-STATE STUDENTS FOR ANY CALCULATION OF THE
5 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM'S STUDENT POPULATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Part 5 of Article 3 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is
8 amended by adding a new section to read:

9 "**§ 116-43.15. Calculation of in-State and out-of-state students.**

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, The University of North Carolina and
11 its constituent institutions shall not count any out-of-state student as an in-State student
12 for any calculation regarding the student population of The University System."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the
14 2007-2008 academic year and each subsequent academic year.
