A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CAPITAL FUNDS TO JOHNSTON MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HOSPICE AND
PALLIATIVE CARE CENTER IN JOHNSTON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Johnston Memorial Hospital Authority the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to supplement other funds obtained by Johnston Memorial Hospital Authority for the construction of a hospice and palliative care center in Johnston County. Any unencumbered and unexpended funds on June 30, 2008, from this appropriation shall not revert to the General Fund but shall remain with Johnston Memorial Hospital Authority to be used for the purpose authorized in this act.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
