12 13 **SECTION 1.** 18B-300(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Consumption at Off-Premises Establishment. — It shall be unlawful to consume, or for a permittee-permittee, a permittee's agent, or a permittee's employee to allow the consumption of, malt beverages or unfortified wine on any premises having only an off-premises permit for the kind of alcoholic beverage being consumed."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
