A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ADD EMPLOYEE OR AGENT TO THE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE
3 PROHIBITED FROM ALLOWING CONSUMPTION OF MALT BEVERAGES
4 AND UNFORTIFIED WINE ON THE PREMISES OF AN OFF-PREMISES
5 ONLY ABC PERMITTED LOCATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** 18B-300(b) reads as rewritten:

8 "(b) Consumption at Off-Premises Establishment. – It shall be unlawful to
9 consume, or for a ~~permittee~~-~~permittee~~, a ~~permittee's agent~~, or a ~~permittee's employee~~ to
10 allow the consumption of, malt beverages or unfortified wine on any premises having
11 only an off-premises permit for the kind of alcoholic beverage being consumed."

12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
13 offenses committed on or after that date.
