allow the consumption of, malt beverages or unfortified wine on any premises having		g
only an off-premises permit for the kind of alcoholic beverage being consumed."		
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to		
offenses committed on or after that date.
