The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall	l make
information and application forms, for expunction of records when charge	ges are
dismissed or there is a finding of not guilty, available on the Internet. Each	clerk of
court shall post a notice regarding the possibility of eligibility for expunction of	records
when charges are dismissed or there is a finding of not guilty. The notice s	shall be
posted in a conspicuous location, to which the public has access, in the clerk's	office.
The notice to be posted shall be developed by the Administrative Office of the	Courts
and shall include the Internet address where a person may obtain more informat	ion and
application forms for requesting an expunction of a record.	

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007.
