A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT AN ACADEMIC
ENRICHMENT AND LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE FOR MINORITY MALES AT
NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred thousand
dollars (\$300,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred thousand
dollars (\$300,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina
Leadership Institute Foundation, Inc., to support an academic enrichment and leadership
institute for minority male youth in grades 9-12. These funds shall be used to implement
any initiative relating to the institute, including any of the following:

- (1) A summer residential academic enrichment and leadership institute for
minority males who are performing below grade level or at risk of
academic failure.
- (2) An after-school program during the regular school year on character
training.
- (3) A seminar to heighten awareness of the plight of minority males in
education and gang-related activities.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
