3	Whereas, the process of determining municipal boundaries has given broad
4	discretion to municipalities; and
5	Whereas, questions of fundamental fairness have arisen when through a
6	process of voluntary and involuntary annexations, patterns have occurred, documented
7	by exhaustive histories and research, whereby lower income areas which have large
8	minority populations have been excluded from the corporate limits of municipalities
9	while predominantly nonminority wealthier areas have been annexed; and
10	Whereas, the General Assembly finds it necessary to ensure a fundamental
11	level of fairness in annexations; Now, therefore,
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
13	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-48 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
14	"(g) If the area to be annexed is wholly or partly within the extraterritorial
15	planning jurisdiction of the city (whether under G.S. 160A-360 or local act) it may not
16	have a racial composition that is a lower minority percentage than the composition of
17	the entire extraterritorial planning jurisdiction of the city. In order to comply with this
18	provision, the city may annex together in one proceeding different areas which, while
19	contiguous to the city, are not contiguous to each other, and apply the tests required by
20	this section to the entire area being annexed."
21	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 160A-36 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
22	"(f) If the area to be annexed is wholly or partly within the extraterritorial
23	planning jurisdiction of the city (whether under G.S. 160A-360 or local act) it may not
24	have a racial composition that is a lower minority percentage than the composition of
25	the entire extraterritorial planning jurisdiction of the city. In order to comply with this
26	provision, the city may annex together in one proceeding different areas which, while

- contiguous to the city, are not contiguous to each other, and apply the tests required by this section to the entire area being annexed." 1
