A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AMERICA

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AMERICAN INDIAN MOTHERS, A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Commission of Indian Affairs, the sum of one hundred fifty-three thousand four hundred ninety dollars (\$153,490) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for American Indian Mothers, a nonprofit organization providing services to improve the quality of life for families throughout the rural community in 17 counties in the State. These funds would be used for administrative costs, programs costs, and other expenses associated with providing family counseling, health services, educational programs, and other services provided by American Indian Mothers.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
