2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ASSIGNMENTS TO THE SPECIAL  
3 ASSISTANCE IN-HOME PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
4 AND HUMAN SERVICES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA  
5 STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human  
8 Services for the 2007-2008 fiscal year may be used to increase the maximum number of  
9 assignments to special assistance in-home program to 2,000 persons.

10 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
