6 Whereas, Bridgeton was incorporated as the Town of Lingfield on February 7 28, 1907; and

8 Whereas, the General Assembly changed the name of the Town to Bridgeton9 on March 8, 1907; and

Whereas, Bridgeton was named for its location at the foot of the Neuse RiverBridge; and

12 Whereas, Bridgeton has continued to prosper through the continued 13 dedication, insight, and planning of the Town's concerned leaders and citizens; and

Whereas, Bridgeton's 307 citizens are very proud of their heritage and "small
town" friendly atmosphere; and

16 Whereas, Bridgeton's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary is worthy of celebration and should 17 be enjoyed and supported by all North Carolinians; Now, therefore,

18 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:
