A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM, ON, OR ACROSS THE  
2 RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A PUBLIC ROAD OR HIGHWAY IN JACKSON  
3 COUNTY, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Except as otherwise provided in this act, it is unlawful for any  
7 person to hunt, take, or kill, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill, with the use of firearms,  
8 any species of birds or animals other than bear or boar from, on, or across the roadway  
9 or right-of-way of a public road or highway, or to discharge a firearm from, on, or  
10 across the roadway or right-of-way of a public road or highway.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act does not apply to an owner or lessee of land adjoining  
12 the public road or highway.

13 **SECTION 3.** A first conviction for violation of this act is punishable as a  
14 Class 3 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent conviction for violation of this act is  
15 punishable as a Class 2 misdemeanor.

16 **SECTION 4.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the  
17 Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and peace officers  
18 with general subject matter jurisdiction.

19 **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Jackson County.

20 **SECTION 6.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to acts  
21 committed on or after that date.
