2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM AT THE
3	UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
6	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred fifty-three
7	thousand sixty-four dollars (\$353,064) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall
8	be allocated to the TEACCH Program in the Department of Psychiatry at the University
9	of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, as follows:
10	(1) \$118,146 for the TEACCHing At Home Program to expand a pilot
11	project to Greensboro and Charlotte TEACCH Centers.
12	(2) \$158,418 to increase faculty salaries to meet minimum requirements of
13	the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Medicine.
14	(3) \$76,500 for student training.
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
