A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM AT THE  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred fifty-three  
thousand sixty-four dollars (\$353,064) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall  
be allocated to the TEACCH Program in the Department of Psychiatry at the University  
of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, as follows:

- (1) \$118,146 for the TEACCHing At Home Program to expand a pilot  
project to Greensboro and Charlotte TEACCH Centers.
- (2) \$158,418 to increase faculty salaries to meet minimum requirements of  
the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Medicine.
- (3) \$76,500 for student training.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
