**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of three million nine hundred ninety-seven thousand three hundred ninety dollars (\$3,997,390) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to raise the funding cap on children receiving supplemental funding for academically or intellectually gifted children. Each local school administrative unit shall receive funds for a maximum of four and twenty-five one hundredths percent (4.25%) of its 2008-2009 allocated average daily membership, regardless of the number of children identified as academically or intellectually gifted in the unit.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
