4	STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7	Department of Public Instruction the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars
8	(\$750,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to establish a two-year pilot program to
9	eliminate multigrade level instruction for high school students with disabilities. The
10	objective of the pilot program is to eliminate multigrade, multisubject, self-contained
11	classes and to maximize integration of children with disabilities into the general student
12	population.
13	The State Board of Education shall select three high schools to participate in
14	the pilot program. The pilot high schools shall maximize the co-teaching models and
15	shall not have any multigrade, self-contained classrooms for students with disabilities
16	The high schools may have self-contained classes by grade level or by subject.
17	The Exceptional Children Division of the Department of Public Instruction
18	shall provide training to the pilot high schools.
19	The Department of Public Instruction shall report to the Joint Legislative
20	Education Oversight Committee on the implementation of the pilot program by
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22	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
