5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
6	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North	
7	Carolina Institute of Medicine, a nonprofit organization, the sum of three hundred	
8	thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used	
9	for studies	conducted by the Institute related to mental health, developmental

- 11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
