	and is required to be placarded under Subpart F of 49 C.F.R. Part 172, or any quantity of a material listed as a select agent or toxin under 42 C.F.R. Part 73.
 (45)	State. – A state, territory, or possession of the United States, District of Columbia, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, a province of Canada, or the Sovereign Nation of the Eastern Band of the Cherokee Indians with tribal lands, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 1151, located within the boundaries of the State of North Carolina. For provisions in this Chapter that apply to commercial drivers licenses, "state" means a state of the United States and the District of Colombia.
