A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTERS.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Secretary, the sum of five 5 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$550,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated 6 7 equally among the 22 fully certified child advocacy centers in this State for expanding 8 forensic interviewing capabilities, increasing multidisciplinary team training, developing comprehensive community responses to child abuse, coordinating and 9 tracking investigative, prosecutorial, child protection and treatment efforts in child 10 abuse cases, and providing treatment and preventing trauma to child abuse victims 11 otherwise caused by multiple, duplicative contacts with different agencies and 12 13 professionals.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
