2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO REGULATE OR
3	PROHIBIT NEW IRRIGATION SYSTEMS FOR RESIDENTIAL AND
4	NONRESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS USED FOR LAWNS AND
5	LANDSCAPING THAT ARE CONNECTED TO THE PUBLIC POTABLE
6	WATER SUPPLY.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> A municipality may by ordinance regulate or prohibit, in new
9	subdivisions and other residential and nonresidential development, irrigation systems
10	for lawns and other landscaping which are connected to the local potable water supply
11	system.
12	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to the Town of Chapel Hill only.
13	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
