A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF

THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO EXPAND

INFLUENZA VACCINES FOR CHILDREN, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE

JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND

DISASTER MANAGEMENT RECOVERY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of four million four hundred ninety-three thousand sixteen dollars (\$4,493,016) in recurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year so that the Division can provide influenza vaccinations to children in this State who are up to 18 years of age.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
