A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF
3 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO EXPAND
4 INFLUENZA VACCINES FOR CHILDREN, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
5 JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND
6 DISASTER MANAGEMENT RECOVERY.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
9 Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of four million
10 four hundred ninety-three thousand sixteen dollars (\$4,493,016) in recurring funds for
11 the 2008-2009 fiscal year so that the Division can provide influenza vaccinations to
12 children in this State who are up to 18 years of age.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
