AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AND SUPPORT AN ASSISTANT COUNTY RANGER POSITION FOR COLUMBUS COUNTY.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the sum of one hundred five thousand one hundred nineteen dollars (\$105,119) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be used to establish and support one Assistant County Ranger position for Columbus County. The appropriation under this section includes forty-five thousand nine hundred dollars (\$45,900) for the one-time cost of providing office supplies and equipment for this position. Notwithstanding G.S. 113-54, Columbus County shall not be required to participate in financing the costs of establishing this position.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
