A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SUDDEN INFANT DEATH
SYNDROME (SIDS) RISK REDUCTION EFFORTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY
THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for the implementation of messages and materials for an ongoing safe Sleep Awareness campaign, which will highlight safe sleep practices to aid in the prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and accidental suffocation/strangulation.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
