11	<u>105-449.43G.S.</u>	<u>105-449.136</u> shall be used to administer the air quality program. Except			
12	for the followin	g fees, all application fees and permit administration fees collected by			
13	the State for permits issued under Articles 21, 21A, 21B, and 38 of this Chapter shall be				
14	credited to the A	Account:			
15	(1)	Fees collected under Part 2 of Article 21A and credited to the Oil or			
16		Other Hazardous Substances Pollution Protection Fund.
