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1	(b) Limit on Impervious Surface of Vehicular Surface Area. – For development
2	that will disturb more than one acre of land, no more than eighty percent (80%) of the
3	surface area of the vehicular surface area may be impervious surface.
4	(c) Building Permit. – No permit shall be issued under G.S. 153A-357 or
5	G.S. 160A-417 for any development that does not comply with the requirements of this
6	section."
7	SECTION 3. G.S. 153A-357 is amended by adding a new subsection to
8	read:
9	"(c) No permit shall be issued pursuant to subsection (a) of this section for any
10	development that does not comply with the requirements of G.S. 113A-71."
11	SECTION 4. G.S. 160A-417 is amended by adding a new subsection to
12	read:
13	"(c) No permit shall be issued pursuant to subsection (a) of this section for any
14	development that does not comply with the requirements of G.S. 113A-71."
15	SECTION 5. This act becomes effective April 1, 2009, and applies to
16	building permits issued pursuant to G.S. 153A-357 and G.S. 160A-417 for which
17	applications were received on or after that date.
