SESSION LAW 2007-259 HOUSE BILL 254

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF CONOVER TO ADOPT ORDINANCES REGULATING GOLF CARTS AND UTILITY VEHICLES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2003-124, as amended by S.L. 2004-58 and S.L. 2007-204, reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, the Towns of Beech Mountain, North Topsail Beach, and Seven Devils Devils, and the City of Conover may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of golf carts and utility vehicles on any public street or road within the City or Town. By ordinance, the City or Town may require the registration of golf carts and utility vehicles, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts and utility vehicles, and specify required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of the golf carts and utility vehicles."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 23rd day of July, 2007.
