11	SECTION 2. Article 5 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by
12	adding a new section to read:
13	"§ 105-164.13D. Sales and use tax holiday for Energy Star qualified products.
14	(a) The taxes imposed by this Article do not apply to Energy Star qualified
15	products in the following categories if sold between 12:01 A.M. on the first Friday of
16	November and 11:59 P.M. the following Sunday:
17	(1) Ceiling fans or room air conditioning units.
18	(2) Central air conditioning units, heat pumps, boilers, or furnaces.
19	(3) Clothes washers, dishwashers, freezers, or refrigerators.
20	(4) Programmable thermostats."
21	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to sales
22	made on or after that date.
