5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 7A-304 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(2a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
8	judicial facilities, the sum of four dollars (\$4.00) to be remitted to the
9	Administrative Office of the Courts."
10	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 7A-305 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
11	"(1a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
12	judicial facilities, the sum of four dollars (\$4.00) to be remitted to the
13	Administrative Office of the Courts."
14	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 7A-306 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
15	"(1a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
16	judicial facilities, the sum of four dollars (\$4.00) to be remitted to the
17	Administrative Office of the Courts."
18	<b>SECTION 4.</b> G.S. 7A-307 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
19	"(1a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
20	judicial facilities, the sum of four dollars (\$4.00) to be remitted to the
21	Administrative Office of the Courts."
22	<b>SECTION 5.</b> Article 29 of Chapter 7A of the General Statutes is amended
23	by adding a new section to read:
24	" <u>§ 7A-343.4. Judicial Department Facilities Reserve Fund.</u>
25	The Judicial Department Facilities Reserve Fund is established within the Judicial
26	Department as a nonreverting, interest-bearing special revenue account. Accordingly,
27	revenue in the Fund at the end of the fiscal year does not revert and interest and other

investment income earned by the Fund shall be credited to it. State facilities fees 1 2 collected or reserved by the Director pursuant to G.S. 7A-304, 7A-305, 7A-306, 3 7A-307, and 143C-4-8 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer and held in this Fund. 4 Moneys in the Fund shall be available to the Judicial Department for maintenance, 5 renovations, repairs, construction, and purchase of State Judicial Department land and 6 facilities. The Director shall report by August 1 and February 1 of each fiscal year to the 7 Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, the Chairs of the Senate 8 and House Appropriations Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate and House 9 Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety, on all moneys collected 10 and deposited in the Fund during the preceding six months of the fiscal year and on the 11 proposed expenditure of those funds." 12 SECTION 6. Article 4 of Chapter 143C of the General Statutes is amended 13 by adding a new section to read: 14 "§ 143C-4-8. Judicial Department Facilities Reserve. Creation and Source of Funds. - The Judicial Department Facilities Reserve 15 (a) is established as a reserve account within the Judicial Department. State facilities fees 16 17 paid as part of court costs for the General Court of Justice shall be placed in the Judicial 18 Department Facilities Reserve. The Administrative Officer of the Courts may further 19 transfer to the Judicial Department Facilities Reserve one-fourth of the unexpended, 20 unencumbered balance of an appropriation, as determined on a cash basis, remaining in 21 the Judicial Department budget at the end of each fiscal year. Nonreverting Funds. - The Judicial Department Facilities Reserve established 22 (b) 23 within the Judicial Department is a nonreverting, interest-bearing special revenue 24 account. Accordingly, revenue in the Account at the end of a fiscal year does not revert, 25 and interest and other investment income earned by the Fund shall be credited to it. All 26 State facilities money collected or reserved by the Director pursuant to G.S. 7A-304, 7A-305, 7A-306, 7A-307, and this section shall be remitted to the State Treasurer and 27 28 held in this Fund. 29 Use of Funds. - Moneys in the Fund shall be available to the Judicial (c) 30 Department for maintenance, renovations, repairs, construction, purchase, and payments 31 toward any certificates or participation for State Judicial Department facilities and land. 32 The Director shall report by August 1 and February 1 of each fiscal year to the Joint 33 Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, the Chairs of the Senate and 34 House Appropriations Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate and House Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety on all moneys collected and 35 36 deposited in the Fund during the preceding six months of the fiscal year and on the 37 proposed expenditure of those funds." 38 SECTION 7. Certificates of participation may be sold by the State 39 Treasurer, in accordance with the State Capital Facilities Finance Act, Article 9 of 40 Chapter 142 of the General Statutes, in the manner, either at public or private sale, and 41 for any price or prices, that the State Treasurer determines to be in the best interest of 42 the State to effect the purchase of State judicial facilities located at 901 Corporate 43 Drive, Raleigh, NC, and more particularly described as Phase Two, Tract A of Raleigh Corporate Center consisting of 17.28 acres and as shown on the map recorded in Map 44

book 1987, page 720, and Map book 1990, page 576, of the Wake County Register ofDeeds.

3 **SECTION 8.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008, and applies to all costs assessed or collected on or after that date.
