A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW REGARDING THE USE OF GED TESTING  
2 FEES BY COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(s) The State Board of Community Colleges may retain and budget fees charged  
7 to students taking the General Education Development (GED) test. Fees collected for  
8 this purpose shall be used only to (i) offset the cost of the GED test, including the cost  
9 of scoring the test, (ii) offset the course of printing GED certificates, and (iii) meet  
10 federal and State reporting requirements related to the test."

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
