A BILL TO BE ENTITLED			
AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION			
PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO COUNTY VETERANS PROGRAMS AND TO			
RAISE THE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE THAT MUST BE PROVIDED.			
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
SECTION 1. G.S. 165-6(9) is repealed.			
SECTION 2. Article 1 of Chapter 165 of the General Statues is amended by			
adding a new section to read:			
"§ 165-6.1. Assistance to counties for maintenance and operation of a county			
veterans service program. (a) The following definitions apply in this section:			
 (a) The following definitions apply in this section: (1) Annual claims filed. – The number of claims filed with a particular 			
county veterans service program during the previous fiscal year.			
(2) Ceiling. – The maximum amount that the Department shall reimburse			
a county under this section notwithstanding the reimbursen			
percentage.			
(3) Reimbursement percentage. – The percentage of the actual amount			
expended during the previous fiscal year by a county for claims filed			
with that county's veterans service program that is to be reimbursed by			
the Department.			
(b) The Department shall contribute to each county an amount on a matching			
basis for any fiscal year for the maintenance and operation of a county veterans service			
program. The amount of the contribution shall be two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or the			
amount required by the following schedule, whichever is greater:
