1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ADD THE TOWNS OF ATLANTIC BEACH, EMERALD ISLE,
3	INDIAN BEACH, AND PINE KNOLL SHORES TO THE AREAS IN WHICH
4	LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES MAY OPERATE
5	ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS
6	OF THIRTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR OR LESS.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 3 of S.L. 2004-108, as rewritten by S.L. 2005-305,
9	S.L. 2006-25, and S.L. 2006-116, reads as rewritten:
10	"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies to the City of Albemarle and the Towns
11	of Beaufort, Highlands, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act
12	applies to the Towns of Atlantic Beach, Cramerton, Dallas, Duck, Emerald Isle, Indian
13	Beach, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Nags Head, Ocean Isle Beach, Pine Knoll Shores,
14	Surf City, and Stanley, the Cities of Belmont, Cherryville, Gastonia, Kings Mountain
15	and Mount Holly, and the Counties of Cleveland, Currituck, Gaston, Surry, and Wilkes
16	only. The term 'municipal employee' shall include employees of a county."
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
