AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE LATERAL ENTRY PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHARLOTTE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at Charlotte to support its lateral entry program. The University of North Carolina at Charlotte plans to implement several strategies that support and expand alternative teacher preparation routes within the next few years.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
