A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO EXPAND AGENCIES COVERED BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT
INTERNSHIP PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-417 reads as rewritten:

"Part 18. North Carolina Internship Council.

"§ 143B-417. North Carolina Internship Council – creation; powers and duties.

There is hereby created the North Carolina Internship Council of the Department of Administration. The North Carolina Internship Council shall have the following functions and duties:

- (1) To determine the number of student interns to be allocated to each of the following offices or departments:
 - a. Office of the Governor
 - b. Department of Administration
 - c. Department of Correction
 - d. Department of Cultural Resources
 - e. Department of Revenue
 - f. Department of Transportation
 - g. Department of Environment and Natural Resources
 - h. Department of Commerce
 - i. Department of Crime Control and Public Safety
 - j. Department of Health and Human Services
 - k. Office of the Lieutenant Governor
 - l. Office of the Secretary of State
 - m. Office of the State Auditor
 - n. Office of the State Treasurer
 - o. Department of Public Instruction
 - p. Department of Justice

- 1 q. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services
2 r. Department of Labor
3 s. Department of Insurance
4 t. Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
5 u. Justices of the Supreme Court and Judges of the Court of
6 Appeals
7 v. Community Colleges System Office
8 w. Office of State Personnel
9 x. Office of the Senate President Pro Tempore
10 y. Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency
11 Prevention;Prevention
12 z. Administrative Office of the Courts
13 aa. State Ethics Commission
14 bb. Employment Security Commission
15 cc. State Board of Elections.
16 (2) To screen applications for student internships and select from these
17 applications the recipients of student internships; and
18 (3) To determine the appropriateness of proposals for projects for student
19 interns submitted by the offices and departments enumerated in
20 subdivision (1) of this section."

21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
