<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by

"§ 58-3-228. Coverage for extra prescriptions during a state of emergency or

All entities subject to this section shall authorize payment to pharmacies for

any prescription dispensed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section regardless

of the date upon which the prescription had most recently been filled by a pharmacist, if 1 2 all of the following conditions apply: 3 The Commissioner issues a Bulletin Advisory notifying all insurance (1) 4 carriers licensed in this State of a declared state of disaster or state of 5 emergency in North Carolina. The Department shall provide a copy of 6 the Bulletin to the North Carolina Board of Pharmacy. 7 The covered person requesting coverage of the refill or replacement (2) 8 prescription resides in a county that: 9 Is covered under a proclamation of state of disaster issued by 10 the Governor or by a resolution of the General Assembly under 11 G.S. 166A-6, or a declaration of major disaster issued by the 12 President of the United States under the Robert T. Stafford 13 Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 14 5121, et seq., as amended; or 15 Is declared to be under a state of emergency in a proclamation <u>b.</u> issued by the Governor under G.S. 14-288.15. 16 17 (3) The prescription medication is requested within 29 days after the origination date of the conditions stated in subdivision (b)(1) of this 18 19 section. 20 The time period for the waiver of prescription medication refills may be (c) extended in 30-day increments by an order issued by the Commissioner. Additional 21 22 refills still remaining on a prescription shall be covered by the insurer as long as consistent with the orders of the prescriber or authority of the dispensing pharmacy. 23 24 This section does not excuse or exempt an insured or subscriber from any (d) 25 other terms of the policy or certificate providing coverage for prescription medications. 26 Ouantity limitations shall be consistent with the original prescription and the extra or replacement fill may recognize proportionate dosage use prior to the disaster. 27 28 No requirements additional to those under the pharmacy provider agreement (f) 29 or the prescription benefit plan may be placed upon the provider for coverage of the 30 replacement fill or extra fill. 31 Nothing in this section is intended to affect the respective authority or scope (g) 32 of practice of prescribers or pharmacies." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 33
