	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 14-163.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read
as follows:	
" <u>(a1)</u> A	ny person who knows or has reason to know that an animal is a law
enforcement agency animal or an assistance animal and who willfully kills or attempts	
to kill the animal is guilty of a Class H felony."	
SI	ECTION 2. G.S. 15A-1340.16(d) is amended by adding a new subdivision
to read:	
"((	6a) The offense was committed against or proximately caused serious
	harm as defined in G.S. 14-163.1 or death to a law enforcement agency
	animal or assistance animal as defined in G.S. 14-163.1, while
	engaged in the performance of the animal's official duties."
SI	ECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
