A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO MANCHESTER CDC, INC.,
HOLLYWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CLUB, INCORPORATED, SEVENTY
FIRST TOWNSHIP CIVIC IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION,
INCORPORATED, THE TIFFANY PINES COMMUNITY OUTREACH
CENTER, AND THE SANDHILLS FAMILY HERITAGE ASSOCIATION TO
SUPPORT COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester Township of Cumberland County.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for community association improvements.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Seventy First Township Civic Improvement Association, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to provide civic, cultural, and senior citizen activities.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man."

SECTION 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sandhills Family Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifteen thousand

1 dollars (\$15,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to assist minority landowners living in
2 Harnett, Cumberland, Richmond, and Moore Counties preserve their lands and protect
3 their cultural heritage.

4 **SECTION 6.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
