10 **SECTION 3.** If Section 5.3 of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,
11 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Occupational and Environmental
12 Epidemiology Branch of the Epidemiology Section of the Division of Public Health of
13 the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of ninety-six thousand one
14 hundred three dollars (\$96,103) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of forty-eight
15 thousand fifty-two dollars (\$48,052) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to implement
16 subsection (a) of Section 5.3 of House Bill 36, 2007 Session.

18 **APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE**
19 **UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA**
20 **INSTITUTE FOR DISASTER STUDIES**

22 **SECTION 4.** If Section 5.3(a) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,
23 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The
24 University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for
25 the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Institute for Disaster
26 Studies (NCIDS), as authorized by Section 5.3(a) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, to be
27 used toward the costs of the following: (i) to assist in establishing NCIDS, a
28 multidisciplinary, interinstitutional, basic and applied research program that applies
29 state of the art concepts and technologies to address urgent and important disaster
30 research questions, and (ii) to assist the campuses within The University of North
31 Carolina to develop crisis management and crisis communications systems that will
32 help individual campuses to better prepare in the event of a disaster.

34 **APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE**
35 **UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO STUDY THE EMISSION AND**
36 **TRANSPORT OF POLLUTANTS AT FIRES AT COMMERCIAL**
37 **HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITIES AND TO FUND RESEARCH OF THE**
38 **HUMAN HEALTH AND ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF SUCH FIRES**

40 **SECTION 5.** If Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,
41 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The
42 University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
43 (\$125,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- 1 (1) Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) shall be used to study the
2 emission and transport of pollutants at fires at commercial hazardous
3 waste facilities, as defined in G.S. 130A-295.01, which study is
4 authorized by Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session; and
5 (2) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be used to research the human
6 health and economic impacts of fires at commercial hazardous waste
7 facilities, as defined in G.S. 130A-295.01, which research is
8 authorized by Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session.
