SENATE BILL 1016*

Short Title: North Carolina Museum of Forestry Funds. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA MUSEUM
OF FORESTRY FOR CAPITAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year for the North Carolina Museum of Forestry established under G.S. 143B-344.23 for capital planning and development. Any unused funds appropriated under this section shall not revert but shall remain available to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for this purpose beyond the fiscal year for which they were appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
