SENATE BILL 1083

Short Title: Wayne Regional Agricultural Center Funds. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO DESIGN AND TO CONSTRUCT A NEW
3 REGIONAL AGRICULTURAL CENTER FACILITY TO BE LOCATED IN
4 WAYNE COUNTY.

5 Whereas, the Regional Agricultural Center to be located in Wayne County
6 will serve as a valuable resource for the agribusiness community in Central and Eastern
7 North Carolina; and

8 Whereas, the Wayne Regional Agricultural Center will address the business
9 of agriculture; promote the importance of agriculture; provide a single, convenient
10 location for effective delivery of agriculture related services; provide a venue for
11 consumer, agriculture-community, and agribusiness education; and will be
12 environmentally unique in its design; and

13 Whereas, the Wayne Regional Agricultural Center will accommodate and
14 house the following entities: North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, the Farm
15 Service Agency, the Division of Soil and Water Conservation of the Department of
16 Environment and Natural Resources, the administration of the Cherry Farm Unit, and
17 the Center for Environmental Farming Systems, which Center for Environmental
18 Farming Systems serves North Carolina State University, A & T State University, the
19 area office of the federal Natural Resources Conservation Service, and the regional
20 offices of the United States Department of Agriculture; and

21 Whereas, the Wayne Regional Agricultural Center will have a positive impact
22 on the economy through biotechnical opportunities, bringing resources to the region,
23 serving the farm community, and creating a value-added incubator center for the farm
24 community; will develop and promote alternative agriculture; create educational
25 opportunities; and develop a collaborative effort and relationship with Wayne
26 Community College and the Mount Olive College Agribusiness Center; and

27 Whereas, agriculture represents over two billion dollars in farm receipts in the
28 six surrounding counties, including Wayne County; and

1 Whereas, the Wayne Regional Agricultural Center, a proposed 60,000 square
2 feet. "Green Facility," is estimated to cost eleven million five hundred thousand dollars,
3 and the local government and community will seek funding from various sources from,
4 but not limited to, the State of North Carolina, the Golden Leaf Foundation, and local
5 governments to construct the Center, with Wayne County retaining ownership and being
6 responsible for future operational costs of the facility; Now, therefore,

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Wayne County
9 the sum of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for the
10 capital costs of the proposed Wayne Regional Agricultural Center as follows:

- 11 (1) To design and develop schematic drawings and plans for the Wayne
12 Agricultural Regional Center facility based on an assessment of needs
13 for agriculture service entities completed in 2006.
14 (2) To construct the Wayne Agricultural Regional Center.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
