Short Title: James K. Polk Historic Site Funds. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PRESIDENT JAMES K. POLK
STATE HISTORIC SITE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to make improvements to the physical plant at the President James K. Polk State Historic Site. These funds may be used to resurface the driveway and parking lot, replace the maintenance and storage building, and add a picnic shelter.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of sixty thousand one hundred sixty dollars (\$60,160) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of sixty thousand one hundred sixty dollars (\$60,160) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to restore two full-time positions at the President James K. Polk State Historic Site.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
