## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE STAGGERED FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE ELLENBORO TOWN COUNCIL, AND A FOUR-YEAR TERM FOR MAYOR.

3 ELLENBORO TOWN COUNCIL, AND A FOUR-YEAR TH
 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 2.2 of the Charter of the Town of Ellenboro, being 6 Chapter 425 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

7 "Sec. 2.2. Town Council; Composition; Terms of Office. The Town Council shall be
8 composed of 5 members, each of whom shall be elected for a term of 2 years four years
9 in the manner provided by Article III of this Charter, provided they shall serve until
10 their successors are elected and qualified."

SECTION 2. Section 2.3 of the Charter of the Town of Ellenboro, being
 Chapter 425 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

13 "Sec. 2.3. Mayor; Term of Office; Duties. The Mayor shall be elected in the manner 14 provided by Article III of this Charter to serve for a term of <del>2 years,</del> four years or until his successor is elected and qualified. The Mayor shall be the official head of the Town 15 16 government and shall preside at all meetings of the Council. He shall have the right to 17 vote only when there are an equal number of votes in the affirmative and the negative on any motion before the Council. The Mayor shall exercise such powers and perform 18 19 such duties as presently are or hereafter may be conferred upon him by the General 20 Statutes of North Carolina, by this Charter, and by the ordinances of the Town."

21 **SECTION 3.** Section 3.2 of the Charter of the Town of Ellenboro, being 22 Chapter 425 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.2. Election of Council Members. At the regular municipal election in 1983 and biennially thereafter, all-<u>All</u> council members shall be nominated and voted upon by the voters of the Town voting at large. <u>At the regular municipal election in 2007, the</u> persons receiving the two highest numbers of votes are elected to four-year terms, and the three persons receiving the next highest numbers of votes are elected to two-year terms. In 2009 and quadrennially thereafter, three members are elected for four-year

1	terms. In 2011 and quadrennially thereafter, two members are elected for four-year
2	terms."
3	SECTION 4. Section 3.3 of the Charter of the Town of Ellenboro, being
4	Chapter 425 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
5	"Sec. 3.3. Election of the Mayor. At the regular municipal election in 1983, and
6	biennially 2007, and quadrennially thereafter, there shall be elected a Mayor to serve a
7	term of two-four years. The Mayor shall be elected by the voters of the Town voting at
8	large."
9	<b>SECTION 5.</b> This act does not affect the terms of office of those elected in
10	2005.
11	<b>SECTION 6.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
